NOTICE FOR CLASS 10 & 12 STUDENTS ATTENDING OFFLINE CLASSES FROM 23RD AUGUST 2021

Dear Parents,

With reference to the consent given by you for your ward to attend offline classes in school, we wish to inform you that the School shall resume offline teaching for classes X & XII from Monday, 23rd August 2021. It is mandatory for your ward to follow the COVID-19 guidelines stated below to attend her physical lessons in School.

- 1. All Students attending optional physical lessons shall be in complete school uniform.
- 2. There shall be No BREAK
- 3. As a limited number of students shall attend per day, they must line up outside the Entry Gate, with monitored social distancing for compulsory thermal scanning. If there is any indication of high body temperature, the student will be immediately isolated and the Parents shall be informed to take the child home.
- 4. The student shall not be permitted to return for physical classes until a negative COVID-19 report is submitted by the designated authority.
- 5. The Students must use hand-sanitizer upon entering the gate.
- 6. The Students shall move directly to their Classrooms and their movements shall be restricted.
- 7. There shall be no canteen on the campus.
- 8. There shall be no outdoor activities.
- 9. The Students should carry their own
 - a. Alcohol based hand-sanitizer for individual use
 - b. Water bottle
 - c Tiffin
 - d Rubber gloves for protection.
